HoD Welcomed all the members and presented the agenda of the meeting for discussion.

Dr.R.Raju, HoD mentioned that it is proposed to seek syndicate approval for the reduction in the intake of B.E (IE) programme from 60 to 40 and M.E programmes (both IE & QEM) from 20 to 15 from the academic year 2019 – 20 onwards. In support of his proposal, he has mentioned that the B.E students strength was increased from 40 to 60 in the year 2014 without commensurate increase in the staff sanction. Also mentioned that the total number of student intake in the Department is [UG – 180 and PG – 100] 280. In the meeting, it is discussed that to meet the NBA requirements as well as AICTE norms, the student staff ratio of 1:15 for UG and 1:12

for PG have to be maintained. Based on this, the total number of staff required is (For B.E, $180/15 = 12$; For M.E, $100/12 = 8.33 \approx 8$) 20. Whereas, the present sanctioned staff strength is only 12. With this sanction, Accreditation is not possible. Therefore, it is decided in the meeting to reduce the students in take which will result in the total staff requirement of (For B.E, $120/15 = 8$; For M.E, $60/12 = 5$)13. With the existing sanction of 12 the department can easily get the accreditation and Approval. Therefore, the committee resolved to seek approval from the syndicate the reduction in intake of B.E (IE) from 60 to 40 and M.E (both IE & QEM) from 25 to 15 from the academic year 2019 – 20 onwards.


HoD thanked all the members and the meeting came to an end.
